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## Block KON 3

### Overview

### Summary of Block KON 3

Block KON3 is an onshore block in the northeastern edge of the inner Kwanza basin. The block is located on the eastern edge of the Aptian-Albian carbonate platform region. The block has an area of 1,385.06 km<sup>2</sup>. It borders block KON 1 to the north on latitude 8° 40' 53", KON 2 to the east on longitude 13° 34' 47", block KON 6 and block KON 7 to the south on latitude 8° 58' 14".

The principal tectonic events recognised within KON 3 are the Cretaceous syn-rift and post-rift phases followed by the development of the Funda-Calomboloca Troughs during the Tertiary.

There is no exploration history within the block, but two nearby blocks (KON 2 and KON 6) have a more extensive exploration history, with successful results. Petroleum potential exists within the northern Funda Trough trend (crossing the block in the west) and in the currently unexplored pre-Aptian syn-rift and early post-rift sequences

The potential of this block is recognised by several leads, with an estimated total of 340 MMBO.
