Overview

Summary of Block KON 17

Block KON 17 is an onshore block in the southeast of the inner Kwanza Basin. It is a square block with an area of 1014.75 Km². It borders Block KON 13 to the north on latitude 9° 50' 19", Block KON 18 to the east on longitude 14° 09' 28", Block KON 20 to the south on latitude 10° 7' 45" and Block KON 16 to the west on longitude 13° 52' 11".

With only two wells and no existing fields, Block KON 17 is underexplored but holds potential for future hydrocarbon discoveries. Two wells, Gunza-1 and Quembeje-1, both encountered hydrocarbon shows in the pre-salt and post-salt sections. Along with several oil seeps in the surrounding blocks, it suggests that an active source kitchen is present. Quembeje-1 proved the existence of excellent quality reservoir rocks in the block in the pre- and post-salt succession.

The potential of this block is recognised by several leads, with an estimated total of 207 MMBO resources.
